The City of Pittsburgh has engaged a consulting team to examine the feasibility of creating a **Transit Revitalization Investment District (TRID)** within the neighborhood of East Liberty within the vicinity of the Port Authority of Allegheny County MLK East Busway. **The East Liberty TRID Study (eLTRID)** seeks to build a strategy to revitalize the neighborhood through transit oriented development within a "Livable Communities' model. This planning study is being completed with a focus on innovation, sustainability, implementation and social equality, representing the vision of all local stakeholders.

As part of the public outreach for the **eLTRID** the City and its consultant team will hold a community planning session in conjunction with East Liberty Development, Inc. In this meeting, we will review the purpose of **eLTRID**, and its progress to date, and we will convene a **planning workshop** to gather public input on what kinds of public improvements should be considered to improve mobility in East Liberty and to encourage transit oriented development around the busway stop. Working in small groups participants and the consultant team will discuss a series of questions about the future of the station area and movement in general in East Liberty.
