

**CITY OF PITTSBURGH FIRE DEPARTMENT: NOTICE CONCERNING MEDICAL  
TREATMENT FOR YOUR WORK RELATED INJURY OR ILLNESS**

The City of Pittsburgh (hereinafter "employer") has selected a list of 6 or more physicians and other health care providers who are available to treat your work-related injuries or illnesses during the first 30 days of treatment. This list is posted at your department's main office for you to view. Also, you may obtain a copy of this list from UPMC Work Partners Claims Management Services at 1-800-633-1197.

If you are injured at work or suffer an occupational illness, you have certain legal RIGHTS and DUTIES under Section 306(f.1)(l)(i) of the Workers' Compensation Act regarding your medical treatment. These rights and duties are summarized below.

**MEDICAL TREATMENT DURING THE FIRST 30 DAYS**

You have the RIGHT to receive reasonable and necessary medical treatment for your work injury or occupational illness. Your employer must pay for the treatment, as long as the treatment is by one of the listed panel providers.

You have the RIGHT to choose which of the listed providers will treat you for your work injury or illness.

You have the RIGHT to switch among any of the listed providers when you receive treatment; and if a listed provider refers you to a provider not on your employer's list, you have the right to receive treatment from the referral provider.

You have the RIGHT to receive emergency medical treatment from any provider. However, non-emergency treatment and follow up care must be given by a listed provider.

If a listed provider prescribes surgery for you, you have the RIGHT to receive a second opinion from any provider of your choice. If that opinion is different from the opinion of the listed provider, you have the RIGHT to choose which course of treatment to follow- IF you choose the treatment prescribed in the second opinion, you must receive the treatment from a listed provider for a period of 30 days after the date of your visit to the provider of the second opinion.

You have the DUTY to visit one or more of the listed providers for the first 30 days of treatment for your work injury or illness if you expect your employer to pay for the medical treatment you receive.

If you seek treatment for your work injury or illness from a provider who is not on the list, your employer may not have to pay for this medical treatment during this 30-day periods.

**IMPORTANT: The list of providers is on the reverse side of this form.**

**MEDICAL TREATMENT AFTER THE FIRST 30 DAYS**

You have the RIGHT to receive treatment from any physician or other health care provider of your choice, whether or not they are listed by your employer. Your employer must pay for this treatment, as long as it is reasonable and necessary for your work injury or occupational illness and has been properly documented by the physician or other health care provider.

You have the DUTY to notify your employer if you receive treatment from a physician or other health care provider who is not listed by your employer. You must notify your employer within 5 days of the first visit to any provider who is not on your employer's list. The employer may not be required to pay for treatment received until you have given this notice.

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**By signing this form I have been informed of and understand my medical treatment rights and duties with regard to work-related injuries and occupational illnesses. **HEALTH CARE PROVIDER PANEL LISTING**

**IN CASE OF A WORK-RELATED INJURY: FIRE DEPARTMENT**

1. You must **immediately** report the injury to your supervisor and also to UPMC Work Partners Claims Management Service at 1-800-633-1197. If there are any questions concerning this Notice, please call UPMC Work Partners.
2. To ensure that the City of Pittsburgh will pay bills associated with medical treatment of your work related injury, you must select from one of the licensed physicians or health care providers listed below.
3. If you require emergency medical care, you may seek treatment at the closest Emergency Department for your initial care, but any additional medical treatment must be obtained by one of the providers below.
5. You are required by law to treat with one of the designated providers listed below for 30 days from the date of your first visit. Failure to treat with these providers may result in the City of Pittsburgh denying responsibility for payment of bills for the first 30 days of treatment. Should it be necessary to treat with a specialist not listed, the panel physician will make the appropriate referral.
6. After the 30-day period, if continued treatment is prescribed, you may choose to go to another licensed physician or health care provider for treatment. However, you must notify UPMC Work Partners of this action within five (5) days of visit to the provider of your choice. Bills associated with such treatment of a work-related injury/illness will be paid if the licensed physician or health care provider files reports as required. (These reports must be filed within 21 days after the first visit and, at least once a month for as long as treatment continues.)
