



PHASE 2 - SNOW WARNING ALERT

*The City of Pittsburgh, Department of Public Works, has issued a
Phase 2 Snow Warning Alert*

PHASE 2 ALERT

3" – 6" forecasted snow/ice

In the case of a Phase 2 alert, the following actions will be taken:

- Full complement of crews working 12 hour shifts around the clock.
- All DPW vehicles and equipment put into salt/plow mode.
- Large equipment concentrating on primary routes.
- Small equipment assigned to secondary routes.
- Recommend that resident vehicles be moved from side streets and alleys if possible.

Please note: Roads are expected to be snow covered by evening rush hour with up to an inch. An additional 2 to 3 inches overnight is predicted before tapering to scattered snow showers Friday, with another half inch possible. Drifting and blowing snow will be the main concern, wind chills will be 0 to +5 on Friday.

Please be advised that our 311 Mayor's Service Center, will not be accepting calls for streets to be plowed until 24-36 hours after the snow event.

In the event of a Medical, Police or Fire Emergency, Dial 911.

Detailed winter weather information provided by our forecasters as of 7:22 a.m. this morning:

- Probability of the Occurrence – 90%
- Storm Timing – Beginning 12:01 – 3:00 p.m. Today
Ending 12:01 – 3:00 p.m. Tomorrow
- Storm Type – Steady Snow
- Area of Coverage – Widespread
- Snow Type – Dry
- Snowfall Accumulation – 3-5 inches
- Snowfall Rate During Event – Early/Light – Middle/Moderate – Late/Light
- Temperatures – Early/26 – Middle/17 – Late/17

- Expected Road Conditions – Road problems to begin between noon and 3:00 p.m.
 - Main roads snow covered
 - Secondary roads snow covered
- Conditions After Event – Cold wave temperatures
