- Safety improvements
- Homeowner counseling
- Window replacement

Please note that the ***first*** priority of the Sustainable Home Improvement Partnership is assisting veterans and families that have already been awaiting much-needed services from our partners. Please note that due to funding limitations, not everyone will be able to be served through this project.
