# PROCEDURES FOR THE APPLICATION PROCESS INTER-MUNICIPAL LIQUOR LICENSE TRANSFER

In accordance with City Council Resolution No. 304 of 2002 and Rule XIX of the Rules of Council, the following procedures shall be followed to complete the application process for an Inter-municipal Liquor License Transfer in the City of Pittsburgh:

- 1. The application shall be submitted to the City Clerk along with a check of \$520.00 for processing, made payable to Treasurer, City of Pittsburgh. The application will be clocked in upon receipt.
- 2. Notification of the application will be sent to City Council for review.
- 3. The City Clerk will review the information contained in the application and verify the accuracy. If additional information is required, the Clerk will notify the applicant.
- 4. The City Clerk will prepare the official legislation for introduction by Council.
- 5. City Council shall schedule a Public Hearing within 45 days of submission of the legislation for a vote to Approve/Deny the application.
- 6. Notification of the Public Hearing will be mailed by the City Clerk to the Applicant, as well as the following:
  - Abutting property owners;
  - Registered community development organizations serving the subject neighborhoods;
  - Liquor Control Enforcement official;
  - Liquor Control Licensing official;
  - City of Pittsburgh Department of Public Safety;
  - City of Pittsburgh Department of Law
- 7. The City Clerk shall prepare and submit a legal advertisement to the Pittsburgh Post-Gazette notifying the general public of the Public Hearing.
- 8. The City Clerk shall order and provide weatherproof Signs that <u>must be posted</u> on the proposed premises. The applicant must post one sign for each one hundred foot (100 ft.) of frontage of subject property. Signs must be posted at least seven (7) days prior to the Public Hearing date, and the applicant must submit proof that the sign(s) was(were) posted in this timeframe by providing a digitally dated photograph to the City Clerk.

**IMPORTANT NOTE**: As part of the process, the applicant must request a background check from the State Police in Harrisburg and a copy of the report must be provided to the City Clerk's Office. This process may take up to two (2) months, so it is important that the applicant request the background check as soon as possible when beginning the application process. The State charges a fee of \$10.00 for this service.

#### AS AMENDED

Resolution amending the Rules of Council to provide procedures for Inter-municipal transfers of Liquor Licenses. Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Pittsburgh as follows:

#### Section 1.

That the Council of the City of Pittsburgh does hereby amend the Rules of Council by adding the following:

#### Rule XIX

## CITY COUNCIL HEARING PROCEDURES FOR INTERMUNICIPAL TRANSFERS OF LIQUOR LICENSES

- a. To request a transfer of a liquor license from within Allegheny County pursuant to 40 <u>47 PA.C.S.A.</u> §4-461, the applicant shall file a completed application with the City Clerk, which the City Clerk shall immediately distribute to all City Council members. The City Clerk will attempt to verify the accuracy of all information in the application, particularly liquor law violations and misdemeanor or felony convictions of owners.
- b. Within 45 days of submission of the completed application, City Council shall schedule a public hearing and vote to approve or deny the application.

#### c. Notice:

- 1. Notice of the date, time, and place of the hearing shall promptly be mailed to the applicant.
- 2. Notice of the application and date, time, and place of the hearing shall promptly be mailed by the City Clerk to abutting property owners, including property owners across the street from the subject property and to any registered community development organizations serving the subject neighborhood.

3. Public notice of the application and date, time, and place of the hearing shall be posted on weatherproof signs provided by the City Clerk on the property to which the applicant has requested transfer of the license. At least one sign shall be posted for each one hundred (100) feet of street frontage up to a maximum of ten (10) signs. Required signs shall be placed along the perimeter of the subject property in locations that are clearly legible from adjacent public streets. The applicant shall submit a photograph of the sign posted on the property to evidence compliance with the posting requirement. The required sign(s) shall be posted at least seven (7) days before the hearing.

- 4. In addition, City Council shall invite to such hearings a Liquor Control Enforcement official and a Liquor control Board Licensing official.
- d. The public hearing shall be conducted as follows:
  - 1. Any Council member who has previously expressed a bias regarding the transfer at issue shall recuse him/herself from the hearing as well as the votes for preliminary and final approval.
  - 2. The applicant may appear in person or by counsel.
  - 3. Procedure:
    - i. The applicant or the applicant's counsel shall make an opening statement in support of their request for the transfer.
    - ii. Council members shall have the opportunity to examine the applicant or the applicant's counsel.
    - iii. The applicant may present witnesses to speak in favor of the requested transfer.
    - iv. Council members shall have the opportunity to examine the applicant's witnesses.
    - v. Abutting property owners opposing the transfer shall have the opportunity to present their reasons for opposition.
    - vi. The applicant or the applicant's counsel shall have the opportunity to cross-examine such opposing witnesses.
    - vii. The opposing witnesses shall have the opportunity to rebut testimony from the applicant or the applicant's witnesses and to make a closing statement.
    - viii. The applicant or the applicant's counsel shall then have the opportunity to rebut the opposing witnesses' testimony and to make a closing statement.

## c. Decision:

- 1. City Council must approve the application unless it finds that doing so would adversely affect the welfare, health, peace and morals of the City of Pittsburgh or its residents.
- 2. Notice of City Council's approval or denial of the application shall be mailed to the applicant at the address given in the application.

- 1. An application for a new license, either retail or wholesale, and certain types of licenses expiring December 31st.
- 2. Application for Transfer of License and Permit, except for the transfer of an existing license from one premises to another premises, PLCB-21.
- Notice of Change of Officers, Directors and Manager or Steward of Club, PLCB-868.
- 4. Notice of Change in the Officers, Directors, Stockholders or Manager of Licensed Corporations, Except Clubs, PLCB-866.
- 5. Application for Approval of Appointment of Manager, PLC8-706.
