## PITTSBURGH CITY CODE § 659.03 - UNLAWFUL HOUSING PRACTICES

Under this Act, it is unlawful housing practice for any owner, real estate broker or any other person to refuse to sell, lease, sublease, rent, or otherwise to deny or withhold any dwelling from any person because of race, color, religion, ancestry, national origin, place of birth, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity, gender expression, familial status, handicap, disability or use of support animals because of the handicap or disability of the user, actual or perceived status as a victim of domestic violence, actual or perceived citizenship or immigration status, actual or perceived preferred language, or hairstyles and protective and cultural hair textures and hairstyles, or to discriminate against, segregate or assign quotas to any person or group of persons in connection with the sale, lease, sublease, rental, assignment or other transfer of the title, leasehold, or other interest in any dwelling or dwellings.

This notice, which has been prepared and distributed by the Pittsburgh Commission on Human Relations, must be posted by any owner, lessee, proprietor or manager of a housing unit. Notices must be posted conspicuously in easily accessible and well-lighted places in the office, model home, or sample apartment or other places of business where negotiations or agreements are customarily made for the renting or purchasing of housing accommodations.

Complaints must be filed within one year of the alleged act of discrimination.
