- Stewards will be provided with supplies and will check in with Allegheny Cleanways through the duration of the stewardship

- Allegheny Cleanways is proposing the CPC purchase supplies to host a stair stewardship in the Hill District – Allegheny Cleanways will be a pass-through group to provide funding to community groups applying to be stair stewards
