Overview of Project:

The Prime (Center for Employment Opportunities) will be responsible for a range of activities aimed at improving community spaces and engaging residents. This includes organizing regular cleanup events to maintain public spaces, educate the community, and ensure a litter-free environment. The organization will be tasked with picking up litter and trash in the rights-of-way, on sidewalks, and in the streets, including the removal of larger items like tires, televisions, and electronics from empty lots in designated areas. Additionally, these lots will be monitored on a daily basis to maintain cleanliness and order. Addressing abandoned properties within the community is another critical responsibility. The organization will identify and address these properties, report to relevant authorities, coordinate cleanup efforts, and advocate for property revitalization. Weed and vine removal from empty lots will also be undertaken using small hand tools, without the use of saws or electrical tools, ensuring a safe and eco-friendly approach. Community engagement is a key aspect of the organization's community steward.
