Overview of Project:

The City of Pittsburgh, Department of Mobility & Infrastructure (DOMI), seeks construction services to remediate a landslide and stabilize Herndon Street in the 20th Ward, approximately 400 feet northeast of its intersection with Furley Street. The Work includes the construction of a ~200-foot cantilevered soldier beam and precast concrete lagging wall, full-depth roadway reconstruction with an added parking lane, traffic control, slope restoration, seeding/planting, and associated items as indicated on the Contract Drawings and in the Special Provisions.
