Overview of Project:

The City of Pittsburgh Office of Management and Budget, on behalf of the Department of Public Works, is soliciting services to replace an existing UPS system and associated components at the City of Pittsburgh's Emergency Operations Center (EOC). The existing UPS system has exceeded its service life and is not functional.

The work will include demolition and appropriate disposal of old equipment, procurement and installation of new specified equipment (including submittals), and engaging a crane and rigging company to get some system components to their specified locations on the second floor of the building.

All electrical work, wiring, connections, and associated equipment within the area of work shall be as per applicable articles of the National Electrical Code as well as all applicable federal, state, and local codes. Coordinate with specifications for device requirements.
