Zoning Map and Text Amendment Council Bill 2024-0959

An application was submitted for a Zoning Map and Text Amendment to amend and supplement the Pittsburgh Code, Title Nine, Zoning Code, Article VI, Chapter 919, Signs, to create and establish the North Shore Entertainment District and set forth regulations for Neighborhood or District Gateway signs. The City of Pittsburgh Planning Commission will hold a public hearing on the proposal and make a recommendation to City Council.
