





## **Project Background**

- Recreation Center closed in 2003.
- Spray pad constructed in 2009.
- Playground constructed in 2018.
- Conceptual Design Community Meetings (2018-2021).
- City hired consultant team to develop park renovation & building project based on 2021 Concept.
- Concept Planning & Design Community Meeting (April 9, 2025)
- Community Meeting (August 13, 2025)
- Planned Construction Funds for 2027.



## **Project Background**

- Project consists of the following:
  - Demolition of the existing items: spray park, recreation center building, playground, and restroom/concession stand building
  - New construction for the following proposed items: spray park, recreation center building (with integral concession stand and park restrooms), playground, pavilion, and parking lot accessing Goettman Street. Small storage shed to be added at baseball fields.
  - Existing Park features to remain: outdoor basketball court and baseball fields







#### AGE APPROPRIATE ZONES

### GENTLE ACTIVITY ZONE INFANT/TODDLER

#### Learning to enjoy texture and water

- Lower, delicate ground sprays
- Lower structures with gentle water formations
- Placement of features close to perimeter and dry zones ensure easy adult supervision and interaction

#### UNIVERSAL ZONE ALL AGES


#### Variety of structures for the whole family

- •Unique water formations pour, dump, spray wiggle, launch and spin
- •Combines ground spray and structures for all ages
- Centrally placed in splash pad and often a transition zone from Gentle activity to Dynamic

### **DYNAMIC ZONE** 7+ YEARS

#### Continual excitement and interaction

- High Volume, highly interactive spray features and Climb 'N Play structures
- Combination of sprays and structures
- Placement of features close to perimeter and dry zones ensure easy adult supervision and interaction
















# **Building Materials**



## **Building Floor Plan**

#### Project Approach

- · Multipurpose Community Room with half court gym.
- Flex Programming space for recreational activities (ping-pong, exercise classes, educational training sessions), rental space for parties or events, or rental space for nonprofit organization.
- . Gym faces the playground creating connectivity to the park.
- Circulation along the exterior wall with glass facade to create connectivity with the urban context.
- · Exterior porch with views to the river.


