The University of Pittsburgh has many years of engagement with Hazelwood Community and targeted engagement surrounding the project located on Lot 18 of Hazelwood Green. Project details are as follows: 185,000 Sq Ft 68 ft tall Two stories plus penthouse Two pocket parks LEED Gold Certification

There is also an opportunity for public art on the screen area of the building. An overview of the project schedule was also provided, beginning with site prep in Fall of 2023 and building foundation 1st half 2024. Referencing to anchoring the system in Hazelwood; Bio manufacturing facility producing cell and gene therapies to treat diseases. This project is Expected to generate hundreds of jobs, inclusive of Hazelwoodians, or Hazelwood residents.

Also there will be a PLDP Amendment to change Street D to a shared way, language has been drafted and presented to the Department of City Planning.

Formal Description: Construction of a +/- 180,000 SF Research & Development building for the University of Pittsburgh over 2 stories. As well as, a proposed Minor Amendment to the SP-10 Hazelwood Green Preliminary Land Development Plan (PLDP).
