

Liberty Avenue

Strip District

The purpose of the Liberty Avenue HSIP Project is to improve the safety of pedestrians and vehicles along Liberty Avenue through the Strip District corridor. Lane reductions are planned to bring existing lane widths to appropriate dimensions. Traffic signal upgrades enhance visibility while upgraded controllers and possible new signal implementations provide more efficient vehicular movement. Pedestrian pushbuttons, ADA accommodations, and count down signals improve pedestrian safety and mobility.

Coordination between agencies, stakeholders, and other projects within the Strip District is a major consideration for these Liberty Avenue improvements.

Construction will begin Summer 2023.
