SAFETY GUIDELINES

Team Captains should verbally go over safety procedures with all volunteers beforehand

- Use gloves, masks, and eye protection if possible or comfortable.

All trash should be collected in a single, truck - accessible area if possible. Different types of trash need to be processed differently, please separate out by:

- 1. "White Goods" large appliances such as fridges, washing machines, etc
- 2. E-Waste and Household Hazardous Waste such as TVs, computers, paint cans, chemicals, etc.
- 4. Bags of normal garbage
