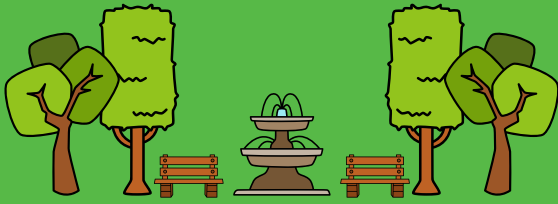

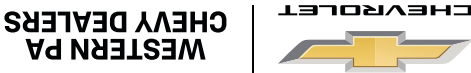
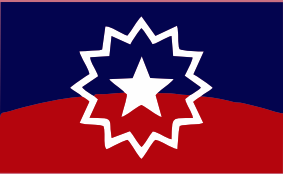
PISTONS IN THE PARK
