

PICKLEBALL WAITING SYSTEM 4 ON/4 OFF

Players waiting for a court, place 1 paddle into the first available open slot in Paddle Rack. White sliding ball/"Next Up" indicator shows who gets next court.

If there are more players waiting than available spaces in Paddle Rack, players shall wait by placing paddle under the rack on the ground.

GAME PLAY is done on a ONE Game rotational basis when all courts are in use and players are waiting. No new games can be started when players are waiting.

Games are played to 11 points, win by 2 (with a 1 hour maximum time limit—most games will take 15 minutes).

ALL players must fully vacate court at the end of a game. Players who have finished must place paddle in Paddle Rack if they wish to rotate back on to the court for another game. Players may NOT have paddle in Paddle Rack and be playing simultaneously.

NEXT waiting players will take the vacated court.

If you are not available when your paddle is up, your paddle will get skipped to speed up the process.
