The Pittsburgh Bureau of Police offers residents a chance to engage in police training and learn about the Police Bureau's roles and responsibilities. Citizen's Police Academy (CPA) is **free** program that provides a safe environment for exploring police operations. Participants receive two hours of training weekly for 12 weeks, covering topics like criminal law, patrol tactics, police accountability, specialized units, police canines, and crime scene processing. **Applicants must be at least 18.**
