This Sunday's Brunch Recipe

BLUEBERRIES & CREAM CHEESE COFFEE CAKE

INGREDIENTS:

1/4 c. sugar

1/2 c butter

2 eggs

1tsp baking powder

1tsp salt

2 1/4 c flour

3/4 c. milk

2 c. blueberries

4 c. water

8oz. cream cheese, cubed

Topping: 1/4 c. sugar, 1/4 c. flour, 2 tbsp butter,
1/2 tsp cinnamon

DIRECTIONS: Cream sugar and shortening until fluffy. Add eggs, one at a time, and mix well. Combine 2 c flour, baking powder and salt. Add this to creamed mixture alternately with milk and water. Toss blueberries in remaining 1½ c flour and fold into batter with cream cheese. Pour into greased and floured 9x13 pan.

Combine the sugar, flour and cinnamon. Cut the butter into flour mixture until it resembles coarse crumbs. Sprinkle over batter. Bake at 375 degrees for 1 hour.
